MARIN COUNTY PARKS: Martin/Pearson – presented the update report as written and submitted in the Agenda packet. Pearson presented Update Report on Bolinas Wye Project. Marin County Parks partnering with West Marin Environmental Action Committee in an MOU to provide docents at Agate Beach in an effort to educate the public about Duxbury Reef. Morgan Patton from WMEAC will present on the MOU when it is complete.

GFNMS: Brown – Cordell Bank is merging with GFNMS. She is hiring for coordinator positions (Resource Protection Coordinator, Education Outreach Coordinator). Brought up Blue Carbon literature review. Mentioned update on the American Challenger shipwreck in Tomales Bay.

GGNRA: Forrestel – The Air Tour Management Plan is out right now for comment period. Stinson Beach Parking Lot Repairs Environmental Assessment undergoing November 18 virtual public meeting.

PT. REYES NATL. SEASHORE: Forrestel – Opportunity for monitoring and enforcement here for commercial use of Air Tour guidelines. Black Bear sighting all around but most significantly in the 5 Brooks Area. Coho Salmon report to be presented next meeting.

FERRIS (Bolinas Rod and Boat Club) – The Boat club has been less crowded recently. Very foggy weather has meant good fishing conditions. Lots of anchovy, surf smelt.

MUELLER (College of Marin Lab) – Update on the Field Station. Funding sources, \$4.5M project half through Measure A, also a \$650,000 donation. Design update, the architecture team is currently developing the indoor and outdoor lab areas. He expressed disappointment that in the demolition of the old building the wood was not salvaged for reuse.

LOOMANS (Stinson Beach) – No bears sighted, but there has been flooding recently at Eskoot Creek.

HEISTAND (ACR) – The Black Bear was also sighted at Audubon Canyon Ranch property. Also they would be doing more burn work (chainsaw/burn piles). New CEO (Tom Gardali). Modus tower on Griffin Preserve land.

STENZEL (Point Blue) – Point Blue in the process of a shorebird survey.
