

## Marin County IPM Program Application for Limited Use Exemption

Proposed Material: AquaMaster EPA Reg. Number: 524-343

Active Ingredient: Glyphosate

Amount of material needed: appx. 64 ozs.

Location of Proposed Use: approximately 5000 sq/ft area adjacent to the Pixie Trail just below Cape Ct. in the Homestead Valley Land Trust CSA #14, Mill Valley

Reason why Restricted: IPM Commission has requested that Glyphosate products be placed on the exemption list while further studies are completed.

Reason for Need: Invasive French broom removal/Habitat restoration project

Options/Alternatives: Hand pulling and mechanical cutting of the broom population has occurred over the past several years. This multi-year project is almost complete in eradicating the broom from this site. This application should reduce the population to near zero.

Plan to Preclude Future Use: Install drip irrigation followed by the installation of native plants. Monitor broom and continue hand and mechanical removal when it re-appears.

Time Period Needed: The exemption request is for a single application that will take place between mid-February and mid-March weather dependent.
