**Statement by Guillermo Rodriguez, California State Director
for The Trust for Public Land, on the San Geronimo Golf
Course Property**

“The Trust for Public Land remains committed to the conservation of the San Geronimo Golf Course property, and to its partnership with Marin County, for the benefit of all members of the public. We believe that this land is best owned by the public and that decisions over its future uses should be made through a public process. The Trust for Public Land does not plan to own this property indefinitely. If the Court rules against the County, we will have no choice but to explore all options. As stated previously, we do not anticipate being able to extend the County’s subsidized management of the golf course.”
