RESOLUTION OVERRULING PROTESTS

RUSH CREEK LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING DISTRICT

The Marin County Board of Supervisors resolves:

1. **WHEREAS**, on September 12, 1995, the Board of Supervisors opened a public hearing on the Resolution of Intention and the Engineer's Report on the proposed improvement in the Rush Creek Landscaping and Lighting District;

2. **WHEREAS**, interested persons were invited to make protests or objections to the proposed improvement, the extent of the assessment district or the proposed assessment, at or before the time set for hearing;

3. **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors hereby overrules each of these protests, written or oral;

4. **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors finds that the protest received by the Board against the proposed improvement (including all written protests not withdrawn in writing before the conclusion of the protest hearing) is made by the owners of less than one-half of the area of the land to be assessed;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin hereby adopts the Resolution Overruling Protests.
