Proposed Material: Wasp Freeze EPA Reg. Number: 499-362

Active Ingredient: Allethrin & Phenothrin

Amount of material needed: 17.5 oz (usually one pre-measured can) per nest.

Location of Use: Marin County Park Lands

Reason why Restricted: Product is on Marin County IPM Allowed Products list. This exemption is requested for use of the product with less than 4 days prior notice in emergencies (i.e. someone has gotten stung, nest is in vicinity of people, creating public/employee safety concerns)

Reason for Need: Active yellow jacket nests

Options/Alternatives: Traps have been placed and are monitored throughout parks

Plan to Preclude Future Use: Continue to actively monitor and trap insects including queen wasps during appropriate time of the year.

Time Period Needed: This exemption request is for the remainder of 2017.
