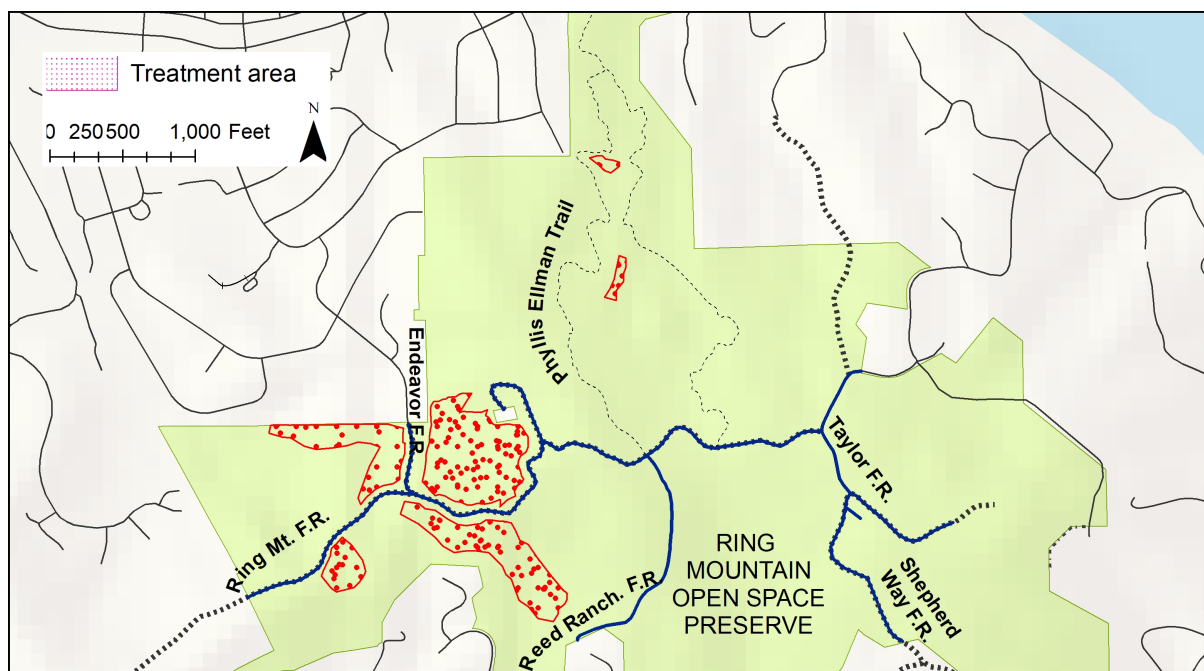

# PREVENTING INVASIVE WEEDS

August 8 - 17, 2022



Mayten, cotoneaster, fennel, and cherry plums are fast-growing invasive plants, which can spread quickly if left unmanaged. Staff carefully places a small amount of herbicide, by hand, onto the trunk or stem of a plant.

Stopping the spread of these invasive species helps to protect rare species like the Tiburon Mariposa lily, and reduces fire risk.
