

MAYTEN REMOVAL

September 2023



The Marin County Open Space District and Marin County Fire are in partnership to implement a fire fuel reduction project that will help reduce fire risk to neighbors bordering Baltimore Canyon open space while also protecting habitat within the preserve.

In August 2023, Marin County Fire cut mature Mayten trees within the defensible space of neighboring homes, then piled the material for burning.

In September 2023, Marin County Parks staff will carefully treat the cut stumps and resprouts with a triclopyr-based herbicide to prevent regrowth.
